

## MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

In order for you to enjoy your awning for a long time we ask you always to check:

- **Regulation of the lead bar** (*please refer to page 4 of the trouble shooting guide*).

- **Regulation of the arm** (*please refer to page 6 of the trouble shooting guide*).

- **Lubrication**

Awnings have self-lubricating joints. They don't need any lubrication. Only the roller tube bearings have to be lubricated with grease.

- **Cleaning of the aluminium profiles**

We suggest you to use abrasive paste properly indicated for anodized painted aluminium.

- **Cleaning of the fabric**

Make sure that your awning is completely dry and clean before closing it.

The remaining humidity could cause stains. If however you have no choice but closing the awning when it is still wet, make sure to open it for drying within 12 hours maximum.

Most of the dirt is superficial and can be removed with clean water and a cloth or a brush. If the fabric is very dirty, add some light cleaning detergent. Be aware never to use any aggressive chemical substances and never to clean the fabric with a high pressure machine.

We recommend not to use the awning at a temperature below 0°C. With time the influence of weather could cause change in colour.
